## Hark! Hark! Parades are at hand!

Can you believe the holiday parade season is upon us? We kick off our parades in downtown Mooresville on Tuesday, Nov. 22.

Line up is at 2 p.m. The parade begins at 3:30 p.m., but roads close at 3 p.m. Please be at our line-up site, at the corner of North Main Street and Culp Street, *no later than 2:30 p.m.*, and plan for heavy traffic! You will drop your child off with us then park at the end of the parade route, near the old Burlington Mills. Please have your children use the restroom before dropping them off at the line-up site.

After parking, find yourself an Acro “watching spot;” we perform where the largest crowds are. Once we pass you, do not continue watching the parade. Pick up your child at the end of the route, then you and your child can go back to watch the remainder of the parade together.

Marchers will turn left onto College Street, while float riders will continue to Burlington Mills. All children need to be picked up ASAP. Please let an instructor/staff member know you are taking your child. If you have not picked up your child by the end of the parade, our policy is to take your child back with us to the studio. Please do not let this happen; it is very upsetting to your child. In case of an emergency, Marie's number is 704-400-9850. But be forewarned that cell systems may be jammed.

All parade participants must wear the following required attire – no exceptions: Acrofitness sweat pants and long-sleeve t-shirts with red shoelaces in Sambas. If it is cold, layer in white undergarments. Black, fingerless, weight-lifting gloves are permitted and highly recommended especially for tumblers and ball participants. Everyone else can wear regular black gloves.

Ball and hoola-hoop participants must bring their own equipment. Hoola-hoopers: put your names on your hoops. Float riders can bring decorative holiday blankets. Please remember to take everything back home with you after the parade is over.

The Davidson and Statesville parades will follow Mooresville's on Saturday, Dec. 3 and Sunday, Dec. 11, respectively. Details to follow.
